THE WATER CRISIS IS REAL

Pakistan has surpassed Ethiopia in water scarcity. In recent years increased global temperatures, erratic rainfall patterns, deforestation, floods and droughts have put the future of our country at stake. This paired with fivefold increase in the population has led to higher demands of fresh water. There are predictions that Pakistan will soon experience water shedding worse than load shedding. If we fail to conserve water Pakistan will run dry by 2025.

Here are a few ways to tackle water crisis

DOMESTIC MEASURES



Use water cautiously in kitchens and bathrooms



Use a mop to clean floors & a wet cloth to wash cars



Water your lawns & gardens at night and use sprinklers instead of a pipe



Store and use rain water for household chores such as cleaning and watering the plants.

AGRICULTURAL MEASURES



Irrigate the fields at night to minimize evaporation



Use sprinkling technique instead of conventional irrigation methods



COMMUNITY BASED MEASURES



Construct ponds at local level & increase the water retaining capacity of present ponds



Plant trees in order to reduce global warming & deteriorating rain cycle



Cover the wells properly & plant trees around them to prevent evaporation



Stop deforestation

INDUSTRIAL MEASURES



Employ a water efficiency program



Educate employees about the importance of using less water



Replace existing equipment with more water efficient equipment



Replace water-cooled equipment with air-cooled equipment



Recycle and reuse water



EACH DROP COUNTS

Among all the looming challenges that Pakistan is facing, water crisis is the most critical problem of the country. According to the world resource institute, the country is among the leading five that face extremely high water scarcity and low access to safe drinking water and sanitation and country would possibly run dry by 2025. All commercial buildings will find cost effective benefits in *RAINWATER HARVESTING*. Any building with a large square foot roof, and high demand for non-potable water, is a top priority candidate for *RAINWATER HARVESTING*.

In some commercial circumstances more than half of the water used each day can be replaced with rainwater. This amount includes flushing toilets, laundry, gardening, irrigation and vehicle washes. Where the majority of use is for industrial process or cooling water the savings would be even greater.



Collective efforts for rainwater harvesting, even in irrigated areas by individual farmers at their farms, can bring a revolution in livelihood in this country, along with a solution to the groundwater recharge for future use

OGDCL CONDUCTS FREE EYE CAMPS ACROSS THE COUNTRY

BACKGROUND

In Pakistan, hundreds of people go blind every day, often from preventable causes like Cataract (in Urdu -Motia). According to a renewed ophthalmologist "nearly two million people are prone to eye-related diseases in Pakistan and timely treatment could cure 80 percent of these diseases. OGDCL under its CSR Health Program initiated a scheme of Conducting Free Eye Camps at 27 locations across OGDCL Fields and follow up camps at the same locations.

The Free eye camps covered diagnostic OPD with qualified medical and paramedical staff to treat the various ophthalmic diseases with appropriate and required medicines and glasses. Operation Theaters at the respective site were established for performing surgeries.

2ND FREE MEDICAL CAMP GHOTKI

A 1-day Free Medical Health Camp was conducted at OGDCL Social Welfare Dispensary Qadirpur on 10th January, 2018 in collaboration with Local District Government Ghotki and Engro Power Gen Ltd. WATER SUPPLY FOR KARAK

20 pressure pumps were installed in Union Council Chokara Tehsil Takht-e-Nasrati District Karak for an amount of Rs. 4.60 million. The area was in dire need of water supply and heeding the call of the local community OGDCL installed these pumps to ensure that the locals do not have to travel long distances in search of clean drinking water.



WATER SUPPLY SCHEME CHAKNAURANG

Keeping in view the acute shortage of water for the locals of Chaknaurang area initially OGDCL started providing water through bouzers. However in order to ensure a more permanent solution, a well-planned water supply scheme was envisioned for provision of water through pipeline.
