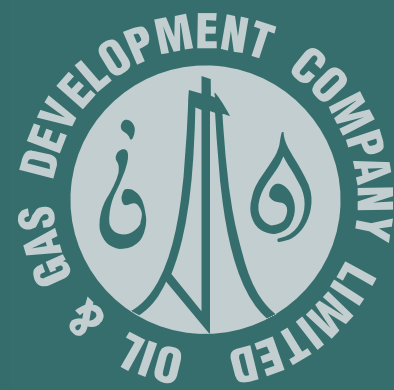

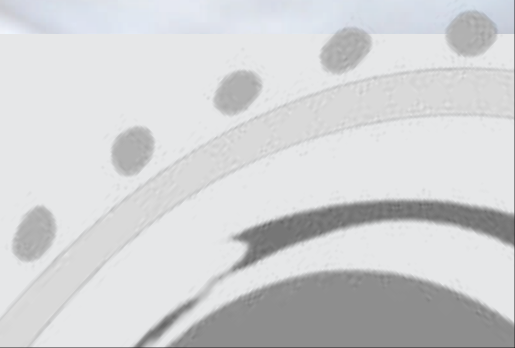

THE RISE OF CSR WORK AT OGDCL

Since its inception, OGDCL has understood that its operations have far-reaching implications beyond just oil and gas Exploration & Production. Early on, the company embraced a vision that went beyond profitability, emphasizing the importance of giving back to the communities in which it operates. This vision laid the foundations for OGDCL's CSR programmes and initiatives. As OGDCL grew, so did its engagement with local communities. In 1982, the company launched its first formal CSR programme by constructing a Girls' School at Pirkoh, Dera Bugti which aimed at supporting education. Realizing the importance of Corporate Social Responsibility, OGDCL established a CSR department in 2013 to focus on empowering the underprivileged and enhancing their quality of life. Educational, healthcare and skill development programmes became regular features of the company's community engagement efforts.

In the last ten years, OGDCL has spent Rs. 9.6 BILLION on CSR for the welfare of people of Pakistan.

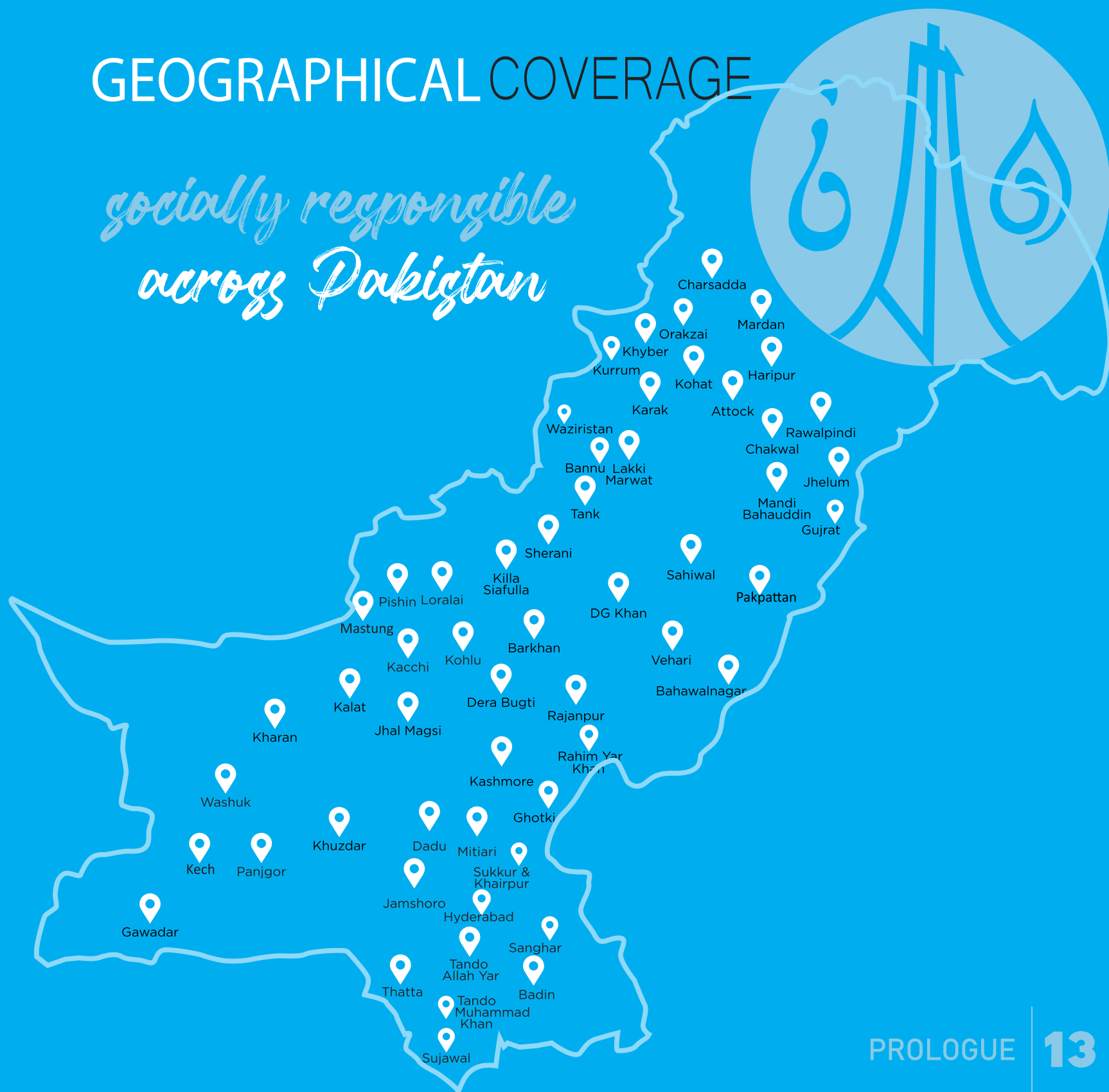

A FLEET OF 100 AMBULANCES

The primary objective of this ambitious endeavor was to enhance the capacity of district health facilities, ensuring an immediate response to the affected population during emergencies.

OVERVIEW

While the CSR work that the company does is constant throughout the year with various project initiatives in its relevant thematic areas, some initiatives are taken as an instantaneous response to a good cause or immediate need.

Recognizing the indispensable role of ambulances in emergency response and preparedness, OGDCL initiated a project to procure and distribute ambulances across the country, especially for locals living in remote areas with a dire need for this facility.

Distributing food rations to the underprivileged households during Ramadan was another CSR initiative that the company thought wise and imperative as it is our belief that the holy month is the bearer of glad tidings and to share your blessings.

By promptly putting these ambulances into service, OGDCL aims to fortify the emergency health system and significantly reduce these life-threatening delays.

One of the major roles these ambulances will play is in

strengthening the referral system, which is a key aspect of achieving comprehensive health coverage. With the delivery and deployment of these ambulances, public health services will be empowered to respond efficiently to medical emergencies. Furthermore, these ambulances will facilitate timely referrals for patients in severe and life-threatening conditions, particularly for individuals residing in hard-to-reach areas or those who cannot afford transportation.

OGDCL's initiative to provide 100 ambulances showcases the company's commitment to improving the healthcare landscape of Pakistan. By addressing the critical gap in emergency services and enhancing the referral system, OGDCL is actively contributing to the welfare of the communities it serves. This endeavor aligns with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being.

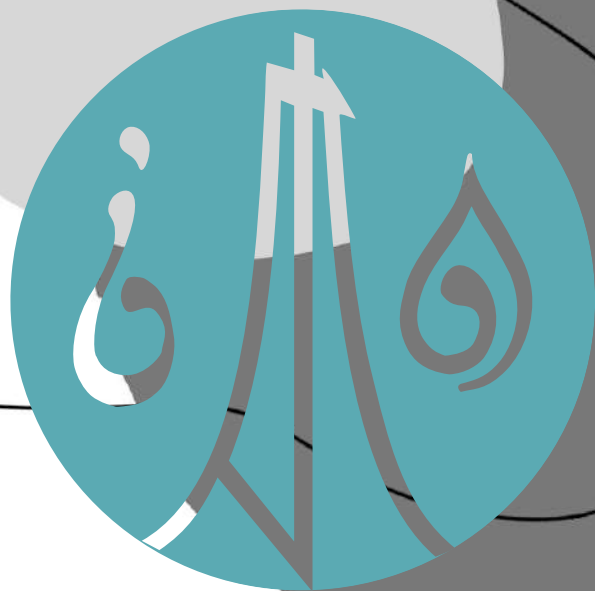
The primary objective of this campaign to distribute Ration bags to 7700 families across the country was to extend support to those in need and ensure that they had access to basic food necessities.

Our Approach

Our activities contribute to economies through taxes, jobs and business opportunities. We also make social investments in the sectors of Education, Health, Water, Skill Development, Microfinancing, Infrastructure, renewable energy, sports, and disaster after the need assessment or in consultation with district Government and local communities.

This investment is sometimes voluntary, or part of our contractual agreement with the Government of Pakistan. In FY 2022-23, we spent PKR 1.5 billion on CSR, of which 20% was required by government regulations or contractual agreements. We spent the remaining PKR 1.28 billion (80%) on voluntary social investment.

In year 2022-23, the Company social investment performance substantially increased by 48% as compared to last year.

OGDCL CONTRACTUAL SOCIAL WELFARE OBLIGATION (PCA)

OGDCL enter into a Petroleum Concession Agreement (PCA) with the Government of Pakistan with the commitment to spend an agreed amount for the welfare of the local communities in the Exploration License area. In line with the Directorate General Petroleum Concession Agreement (DGPC), OGDCL deposits the social welfare funds in the joint account maintained by the Deputy Commissioner and OGDCL representative. Social welfare funds are utilized by the district social welfare committee headed by the MNA/MPA or any other notable of the area. Whereas the schemes are executed by the Deputy Commissioner through line departments.

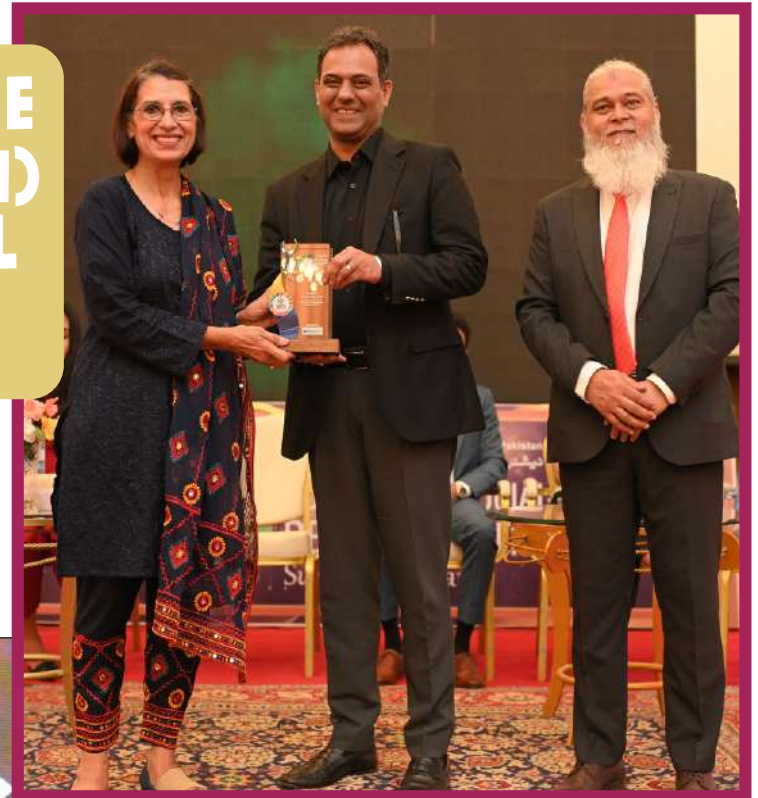

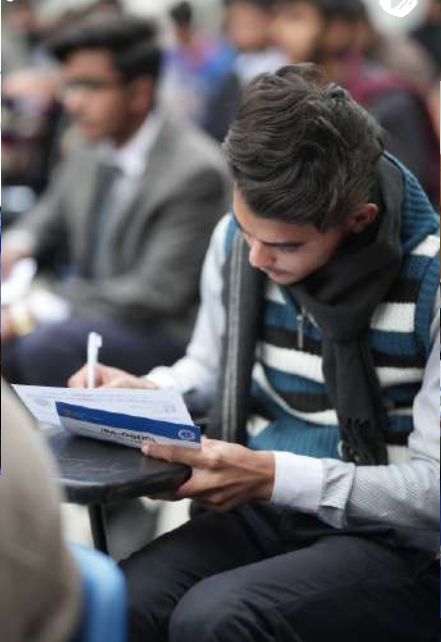

We're going to school! Free education for children of Balochistan

To uplift the local community, OGDCL identified the lack of educational facilities in its operational district of Dera Bugti. It was crucial to resolve this issue promptly, especially considering that the district is the poorest region in the remote and underserved province of Balochistan, where educational system is neglected.

We at OGDCL believe that education is a basic human right, therefore initiated the project to provide free education to newly admitted students in FC School Loti, Pirkoh (Middle Schools), and FC Intermediate College Dera Bugti. The company set aside a budget to provide 242 students with scholarships. Additionally, the firm awarded a stipend of Rs. 2000 to each girl registered in schools until their graduation, alleviating financial pressure for the families. The incentive of the stipend granted to girl students assisted them in continuing their education. This initiative allowed the parents to refrain from incurring financial costs associated with their child's education, while also giving them a chance to build a brighter future for their family. The decision of the company to promote education also supports the government's policy that envisages education for all.

The programme, which is in line with the SDGs, aims to uplift the standard of living of the students by providing them an opportunity to gain employment through **three months free-of-cost skills development courses in ten different trades at the NAVTTC's Centre of Excellence in Islamabad, including boarding and lodging**. An excessive outreach programme was conducted by NAVTTC in the OGDCL operational district, where interviews with candidates were conducted and the final 313 students were awarded a scholarship. Students after completion of the course will be able to secure employment at various platforms, contributing to overall development of the country, and their personal growth and prosperity.

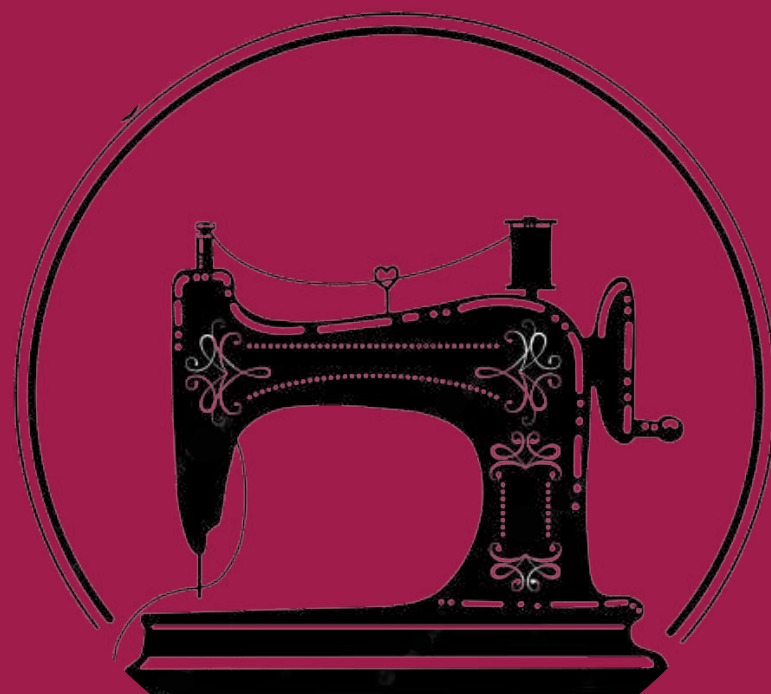
OGDCL WOMEN VOCATIONAL SCHOOL HYDERABAD

SHEDDING A LIGHT ON BLINDNESS WITH SURGICAL EYE CAMPS

OGDCL and Al-shifa Eye Trust conducted OGDCL Free Surgical Eye Camps at 33 locations across OGDCL fields and follow up camps at the same locations. The Eye Camps offered free eye care treatment including eye surgeries

400,000 patients treated till date

In Pakistan, visual impairment and blindness pose a significant challenge, affecting over 9 million individuals. Our project aims to address this problem, targeting people of all ages and genders. One of our key focuses is the early detection of eye diseases in children, as this can prevent future blindness and impairment. Through our initiative, we have already reached out to more than 150,000 beneficiaries across the country, which shall rise in the coming year. We at OGDCL understand what a true blessing it is to have a sight, which is why our vision of making a positive impact in this area remains unwavering.

Community participation in these camps was remarkable and patient's satisfaction level was also high making the project a mega success. The project itself was a second venture with Al-Shifa Eye Trust and was highly appreciated by the locals. Average number of patients per camp recorded was 1,700. An average surgery at a private hospital costs between 60,000 to 70,000 whereas this surgery was carried out at a local level was completely free of cost by OGDCL. We ensured the best quality care, which is why the lenses used in the cataract surgery are made in Germany and are a proof to 100% recovery!

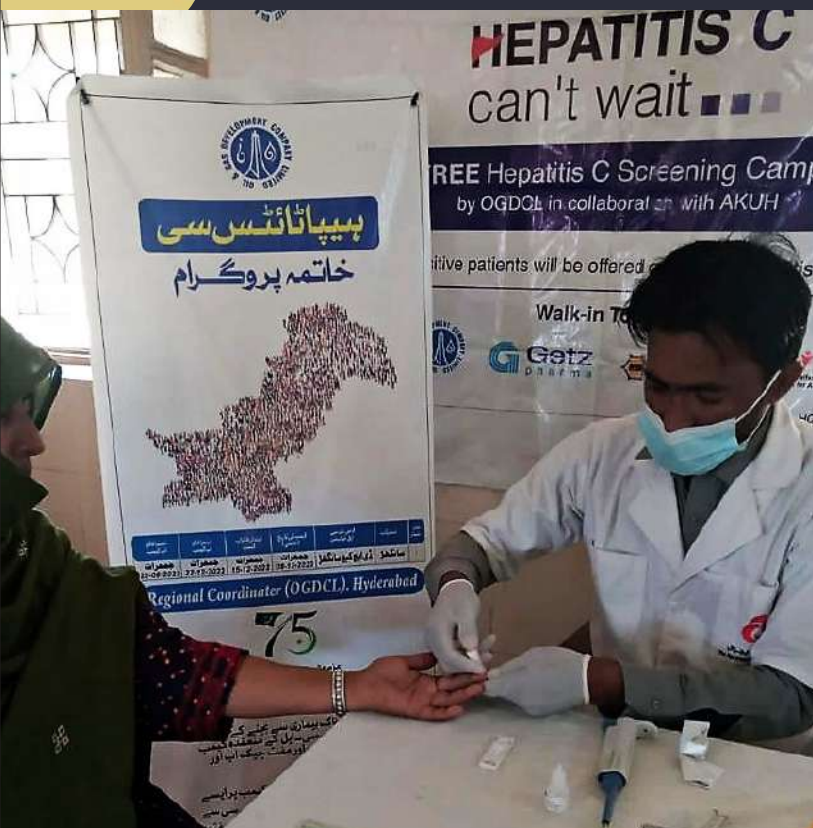

OGDCL & AKU HEPATITIS C ERADICATION CAMPS

Aga Khan University's Outreach Health Network signed an MoU with OGDCL to help provide screening and treatment for Hepatitis C in the communities where OGDCL operates.

Through this one-year collaboration, AKU is continuing to provide access to deserving patients who are unable to afford the diagnosis and treatment. As part of this initiative, AKUH is establishing **Hepatitis C elimination camps at 24 locations across the country, including 24 initial camps and 72 follow-up camps.** These camps will offer comprehensive and high-quality treatment for Hepatitis C to patients residing in the operational areas of OGDCL. AKU's Medical Centre teams are making extensive efforts to visit high-risk areas to screen, identify, counsel, and treat patients who are silently suffering from Hep C. They will continue to work in these communities for mass screening until the agreement ends. Through the generous support of donors like OGDCL, AKU's Hepatitis-C Elimination Programme aims to improve accessibility for all financially challenged patients in the communities.

IMPACT- Since the initiation of the AKU and OGDCL Hepatitis C Camps Programme, we have witnessed a significant impact on the lives of patients and the communities we serve. By establishing elimination camps and offering comprehensive treatment, we have been able to improve accessibility and address the healthcare needs of financially challenged patients. The success of this initiative has motivated us to continue our efforts beyond the one-year collaboration, ensuring sustainable support for Hepatitis C patients.



OGDCL & DOST COMBATING DRUGS FROM SOCIETY

Say NO to drugs!

Oil and Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL) signed an MoU with DOST Welfare Foundation for the social reintegration of the drug-addicted people in the company's operational Kohat district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province.

Launched under the OGDCL's corporate social responsibility, the two-year programme will mainly focus on creating awareness among the masses regarding drug use. Awareness will be created amongst people of various age groups in general and the youth population in particular. The programme will inform local people about ways to prevent drug addiction. Completely sponsored by OGDCL, this initiative will also facilitate the treatment and rehabilitation of drug-addicted people at state-of-the-art rehabilitation facilities by DOST Foundation.



New beginnings... *a success story*

Khalid, aged 26 years, belonged to District Kohat. He was married for three years and had no children. Some of his family members were also drug users and involved in peddling; and so was his wife who also abused drugs. Since they were a family of drug users, Khalid started using drugs at an early age. Due to drug usage, he had a dysfunctional family life; his marital life had no harmony either. Family problems and fights became worse, hence he left home and started living on the streets which resulted in progression of drug use and mental health problems.

His extended relatives started to worry about him, which is when they learnt about the DOST-OGDCL services in District Kohat and approached the Drop In Centre (DIC) for drug addiction treatment. Eventually, after initial services and registration at DIC, Khalid was sent to DOST's residential drug addiction treatment and rehabilitation center in Peshawar. He went through a detoxification phase, having several complaints and symptomatic issues. After a detailed assessment, his treatment plan was prepared by the concerned psychologist, inclusive of counseling and psychiatric medication prescribed by the psychiatrist during his stay at the treatment center. His family was contacted to visit the center despite their reluctance and lack of support. Eventually his family was motivated by the DIC staff to participate in the treatment and rehabilitation programme. They were provided family counseling sessions and the relationship was restored after multiple sessions.

Khalid has shown remarkable improvement and is committed to maintaining his recovery. He has successfully completed his treatment and wants to become a responsible person and a role model for others suffering from drug addiction.

OGDCL & INDUS HOSPITAL GIVING HEALTH FACILITIES

OGDCL signed an MoU with IHHN to enhance health services in local communities by establishing and operating health facilities in various categories.

As a socially responsible corporate, OGDCL has been serving communities by providing health care through treatment and medication. However, with the growing demand for enhanced health services at doorsteps, OGDCL has partnered with IHHN to cater for health facilities at identified OGDCL operational fields. Under this partnership, IHHN will establish and operate health facilities, while OGDCL will sponsor the establishment and operational expenses of all the facilities.

OGDCL SOCIAL WELFARE DISPENSARIES *new & improved!*

OGDCL has revitalized 18 social welfare dispensaries (owned and operated by OGDCL) in its area of operation by rehabilitating infrastructure, hiring professional medical personnel, and providing state-of-the-art medical equipment.

OGDCL has taken a significant step towards enhancing the well-being of communities through these dispensaries which play a crucial role in providing quality healthcare (OPDs and medicines) to underprivileged populations residing in and around the company's area of operation, ensuring that they have access to medical care and the essentials.

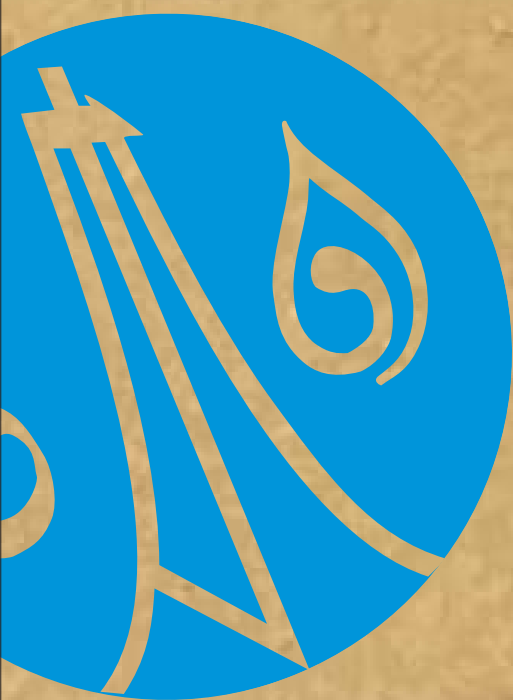
CARE FOR HINDU COMMUNITY
