#### 2.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

#### 2.1 Qualification Criteria

#### 2.1.1 Basic Eligibility Criteria

The applicants (Consultants/ JV/ Association) fulfilling the following basic eligibility criteria shall only be considered for further evaluation (relevant documents to be attached):

- Valid Registration with PEC & PCATP in relevant fields of specialization.
- Valid legal entity of the firm e.g. Certificate of registration from SECP or registrar of firms.
- Certificate of registration with Income Tax and ICT Sales Tax.
   Foreign firms must attach similar certificate from home country.
- d. Judicial Affidavit declaring "Neither the firms nor its Directors, Stakeholders, as a whole or as a part of the firm have ever been black listed/ defaulted by any government agency/ department/organization".
- e. In case of joint venture, all the members have to meet in full the aforementioned Basic Eligibility criteria. Foreign applicants have to form a JV with local firms as required under the PEC bye laws. In case of foreign firms, registration with PEC will not be mandatory at the time of Prequalification. However, they will have to produce license in relevant fields from PEC prior to award of contract.

#### 2.1.2 Detailed Evaluation Criteria

The Applicants must respond to all questions in prequalification documents and provide complete information as advised in this document. Failure of an applicant to provide comprehensive and accurate information that is essential for the Employer's evaluation of the applicant's qualification or to provide timely clarification or substantiation of the information supplied may result in disqualification of the applicant, for which no liability shall be at the employer part and same shall be communicated in accordance with provisions of PPRA Rules.

Pre-qualification will be based on the criteria given in succeeding paras, regarding the Applicant's Experience Record, and Personnel Capabilities as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the forms attached to this letter. Sub-consultant's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the Applicant's compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture. The evaluation criteria is as follows:

Prequalification status shall be decided on the basis of Pass/Fail basis. The applicant must secure at least 50% score in each category, whereas, the minimum aggregate qualifying marks shall be 70 %.

#### 2.2 Joint Venture (JV)

- 2.2.1 Joint Venture must comply with the following requirements:
  - a) Following are minimum qualification requirements:
    - i) The lead partner shall meet not less than 40% of all qualifying criteria given in paras 2.1.2.1 and 2.1.2.3 heretofore.
    - ii) Each of the partners shall meet not less than 30% of all the qualifying criteria given in paras 2.1.2.1 and 2.1.2.3 heretofore
  - b) Any change in a prequalified JV after prequalification process, shall be subject to the written approval of the Employer prior to the deadline for submission of bids. Such approval may be denied if:-
    - Partner(s) withdraw from a JV and remaining partners do not meet the qualifying requirements;
    - ii) The new partners to a JV are not qualified individually or as another JV; or
    - iii) In the opinion of the Employer, a substantial reduction in competition would result.
  - c) Bid shall be signed by all members in the JV so as to legally bind all partners, jointly and severally, and any bid shall be submitted with a copy of the JV agreement providing the joint and several liability with respect to the contract.

- 2.3.2 In case of dissolution of a JV, each one of the constituent firms may prequalify if they meet all the prequalification requirements and any partner of J.V has requested/shall request for the same and then his prequalification shall be subject to the written approval of the Employer.
- 2.3.3 An Applicant shall submit only one application in the same Prequalification process, either individually as an Applicant or as a member of a Firm / Joint venture / Association. No Applicant can be a subconsultant while submitting an application individually or as member of a joint venture or member of association in the same Prequalification process.
- 2.3.3 One of the members who is responsible for performing a key function in executing a major component of the proposed contract shall be nominated as being in charge during the Pre- qualification and bidding period and in the event of a successful bid, during contract execution. The member in charge shall be authorized to incur liabilities and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all members of the Firms/ Joint venture/ Association; this authorization shall be evidenced by submitting a power of attorney signed by legally authorized signatories of all members.

#### 2.4 Employer's Right

- 2.4.1 The Employer reserves the right to take the following actions, and shall not be liable for any such actions:
  - Amend the scope of the work, in which event bids will be invited only from those applicants who meet the resulting amended prequalification requirements;
  - Cancel the Pre-qualification process and reject all applications in provisions with PPRA rules.

#### 2.5 Other Factors

- 2.5.1 The Employer reserves the right to:
  - a) Amend the scope and value of any contract(s) to be bid, in which event the bidder(s) will only bid among those prequalified bidders who meet the requirements of the contract(s) as amended. However the Employer has to review the disqualified bids who originally do not meet the specified criteria for Pre-qualification.
  - b) Reject or accept any application; and
  - c) Cancel the prequalification process and reject all applications.

The employer may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to




