The invoices of Waste Management Services for all activities i-e, treatment till disposal, are initially verified Mud Engineer at Rig Site. Having both personal from same company will creates doubts in authenticity of verification process.</p>

More generic term would be G Force 7.3 above and deck angle 0 to 6 degree. Most of the service providers shall be able to participate with such specifications.</p>	<p>The minimum requirement of Deck angle is 0 to 5 degrees and Minimum G Force is 7 and above.
