1	Referring to Para no. 2 of Section 4 titled 'Financial Bid Format', it is stated that quotation of 'Optional Cost of Cloud Model' will not be made part of financial evaluation. In order to avail maximum discounts from our Principal Technology vendor, we request OGDCL to please make 'Optional Cost of Cloud Model' part of financial evaluation.	As per TOR, OGDCL require only "On Premises e-procurement Solutions" . Therefore evaluation will be made on the basis of On Premises e-procurement Solution. OGDCL has asked for Cloud Model as optional cost which will not be made Part of financial evaluation.
2	Referring to Item no. 2 of Section 5.0 titled 'Technical Evaluation', it is stated that vendor must have a minimum experience of 10 years. We request that this duration be reduced to 5 years, as permissible by PPRA Laws. This will also ensure greater competition as many established local.	Evaluation will be made as per TOR.
3	Referring to Section 4 titled 'Financial Bid Format', users have been segregated by Core Users and Support Users. Please clarify the functionalities expected against these respective user classes as every leading Technology Vendor follow their own licensing terminologies.	Creator of tender will be the core user, whereas all other workflow users will be categorized as support users.
4	Referring to Item no. 2 of Section 5.0 titled 'Technical Evaluation', it is stated that number of global E-Procurement project execution carries 5 marks. We are assuming that OGDCL is referring to the global deployments of the proposed solution.	As per TOR, On premises e-procurement solution is required. However weightage will be given to the product deployed globally. Evaluation will be made as per TOR.
