1.	Please highlight how the crew transportation shall be covered, in case wellsite & accommodation are far apart. And if it has to be covered by the contractor, please provide distance in kms.	The distance of wells from accommodation may varies approximately from 0.5 Km to 60 Km (approx.). However, the above mentioned distance cannot be considered as reference as it may vary for different wells and operational requirement. The charges for mob/de-mob whatsoever from accommodation to well site and from well to well within same field will have to be borne by the bidder in any case.	2.25. Equipment/crew, Mob/De-Mob charges from base to Field will be paid once in case of multiple Jobs on different wells within same field. OGDCL will not pay well to well mobilization charges for equipment and crew within same field.

5.	Please advise, who will be responsible non-conventional safety equipment at well site. Will OGDC provide safety equipment in hazardous non-conventional area. Other non-conventional safety equipment and hazards may be defined categorically by the bidder. However, all safety equipment is to be arranged by the bidder with no additional cost. If in case, OGDCL provides 10 days mobilization time than how will OGDC ensure it to be followed	Mobilization time of 10 days is the maximum allowable time for provision of equipment for at least two simultaneous job regardless of engagement with any other customer. Exceeding this time limit may result in confiscation of PBG and termination of contract. However, any earlier time can be agreed on by both parties in this regard and bidder can only deny	2.30. The maximum mobilization time of equipment/crew regardless of engagement with any other customer is 10 Days.

7.	Please provide the rating, specs & list of x-overs required, in order to cover the cost & time.	The specs and rating vary from well to well and some new connections may be required in the upcoming wells. Clause 2.9 covers all the connections and bidders must provide the required x-overs. However, at this moment the x-overs cannot be categorically mentioned.	2.9. Bidder to manage X-over/s both upstream and downstream for SWT jobs.
8.	What is the max operating & test pressure of 10k equipment.	The maximum operating and test pressure of 10K equipment as per standard allowable limit for is 10K.	
9.	Request for extension in bid submission date of one month	Bid submission date cannot be extended please.
