SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Welding and fabrication of interconnecting pipe spools & Tie-In points.
2. Estimated Dia. Inch for Welding fabrication is between 1200 Dia. Inch to 1500 Dia. Inch (depending on site conditions)
3. Welding & Fabrication of Pipe supports where required.
4. Surface preparation for NDT.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All bidders should carefully read TOR's attached with the Tender documents before submission of Bid.
2. Quoted rates must be on per dia inch basis.
3. OGDCL will not provide any kind of boarding/lodging.
4. Logistics support (Crane, Lifter and Trailer) will be provided by OGDCL.
5. Power will be provided by OGDCL.
6. Diesel Welding Plant if required will be provided by OGDCL.
7. Consumables (Welding Electrodes, Cutting/Grinding discs, Filler wire Oxygen & DA Cylinders, Argon Gas etc.) will be provided by Contractor.
8. Contractor will arrange all tools, machines & equipment (including portable welding machines, grinding & cutting machines etc) required during welding/fabrication.
9. Contractor will provide required PPE's to its labor.
10. Contractor will comply with HSE policy of OGDCL.
11. Contractor will follow the safety protocols regarding Corona Pandemic. While at site the contractor's workforce is required to wear surgical masks at all times and maintain social distancing as much as possible.
12. After issuance of formal work order, Contractor is to provide services immediately or at a date mentioned by OGDCL.
13. Payment will be made through Cross Cheque after inspection of completed jobs as per SOR.
14. The estimated scope of work is liable to change (increase, decrease or omitted) when the work is actually executed. The payment to be made to the Contractor shall be based on the actual quantity of work performed.
15. OGDCL reserves the right to inspect, stop and advise rework for any job either during execution or after execution, if deemed necessary by the Company's representative based on quality of the job, finish of the job or if the job is not being or have been performed in line with the best engineering practices. In this regard the rework will be in Contractor's Scope.
16. Contractor must have prior experience of Welding & fabrication.
17. Partial Payments will not be made, in any case.
18. Management of the plant reserves the right to curtail the job list or terminate the services of any hired staff at any time without any reason.
19. Contractor should ensure the police verification of all manpower direct and indirect and must have bio-data file of each individual.
