2. OGDCL reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason.
3. Quoted prices must be firm in Pak rupees on FOR basis (inclusive of GST, other taxes, and duties).
4. The quotes will be opened on the date as mentioned in the tender notice; the supplier can mobilize his representative to site
5. Bid bond (Bank Draft/Pay Order) of **Rs 2% of the quoted total amount/- exclusive of GST** in favor of Field Manager Nashpa Oil & Gas Field to be submitted at the time of bid submission by all participants.
6. The successful bidder will be bounded to provide the material as per specifications mentioned in the TOR.
7. Performance bond 10% of quoted price will be submitted by the supplier.
8. The successful bidder will be responsible to provide all the materials within 45 days after the issuance of P.O.
9. The variation in Quantity will not change the unit cost of material.
10. Upon receipt of material at site, in case of test failure, material will be returned to supplier and the cost will be borne by of supplier.
11. Original material test certificates will be provided with material.
12. No advance payment will be made at the time of P.O.
13. The delivery and inspection of material will be carried out at Nashpa Oil Field. In case of rejection, all the transportation charges will be at Supplier's end.
14. The material delivery charges to Nashpa Field will be paid by the Supplier.
15. Income tax/w. holding tax deductions will be applicable as per company/govt. rules.
16. Payment will be made through cross Cheque after receiving all the material at site.
17. Firm should have valid NTN & GST number and have an active status on FBR website.
18. The Firm should have active Professional tax certificate of concerned Excise office where operating business.
19. Tax submission Certificate (Annex-C) will be provided along with Invoice.
20. The successful bidder will provide free of cost services to maintain the smooth operations of the quoted materials for a period of one year.
21. Installation and commissioning services will be on supplier's part.
22. Two years warranty of the material is required, any repair/maintenance will be provided free of cost and transportation will be borne by the supplier.
23. Original import documents must be provided along with QC test by the OEM. Refurbished equipment will not be accepted.
