TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Supplier will warrant that all goods supplied against the contract should have no defect arising from design materials and manufacture and that the **supplier should rectify any defect at no cost for a period of one year** under normal use of supplied goods and conditions prevailing in Pakistan.
- 2) The bid to be submitted through two envelopes, one technical and other financial (single stage two envelope).
- 3) The manufacturing company will provide supply record for similar items to clients of international repute (from other than the manufacturer's country) and have 20 (twenty) years manufacturing experience of the similar items. The manufacturer should provide the list with names, purchase order numbers with dates, address and e-mail addresses of clients to whom similar items have been supplied during last 15 (fifteen) years. OGDCL have right to contact these clients directly to know the performance. Manufacturer will provide the copy of the purchase orders for verification.
- 4) Manufacturer will provide performance certificates from "E&P and/or Oilfield Services companies" of international repute (from other than the manufacturer's country). The certificates must be on the company letter head and should indicate the Name & Designation of the signing authority along with his complete contact details including his official email address. The bidder must provide latest E-mail/Fax numbers etc. to directly verify the authenticity of these certificates from the issuing authority/company. Certificates issued by supply houses etc. will not be acceptable.
- 5) Evaluation will be done on "Each Item Wise" basis.
- 6) Maximum **delivery period** will be 26 weeks from issuance of Purchase order.
- 7) For Quality control the O.E.M should be ISO certified. Valid ISO certificate to be submitted with the bid.
- 8) All the items should be brand new (certificate in this regard to be attached).

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CRITERIA FOR TECHNICAL QUALIFICATION

Evaluation of technically qualified bidder will be based on merit. The minimum selection criteria will be 85% aggregate and 75% for each discipline. The weightage percentage allocated for each discipline is shown below
